Service Awards

OACRAO SERVICE AWARDS

In recognition of members who have provided outstanding service to the organization, OACRAO has instituted two service awards. The list of candidates for each award is submitted by the Nominating Committee to the Executive Committee for their selection at least two months prior to the annual meeting. Upon selection, the award(s) will be presented at the annual meeting.

Garland G. Parker Award

The Garland G. Parker Award is given for outstanding distinguished service to the profession at both the state and national level. Candidates may be current, former or retired OACRAOians. The award is named for Garland G. Parker, Ph.D., who served in a variety of roles at the University of Cincinnati, including professor in the College of Engineering and Business Administration, Assistant Dean of Summer School and University Registrar. Dr. Parker also served his state and national colleagues as the President of OACRAO in 1966 and the President of AACRAO in 1976. The award was instituted in 1990.

Linus J. Ryland Award

The Linus J. Ryland Award is given for outstanding service to the profession and to OACRAO. Candidates may be either actively involved or retired from OACRAO. Linus J. Ryland served as Assistant Registrar at Miami University from 1978 to 1993 and Associate Registrar from 1993 to 1995. He served OACRAO as president in 1987. This award was instituted in 1995.
