

2018 OHIO SMALL COLLEGE REGISTRAR MEETING





Ohio Northern University hosted the annual small college registrar's meeting on March 9, 2018 in the Hanson Reading Room, housed in the Taggart Law Library at the Claude Pettit College of Law. Topics discussed were registration processes in terms of business office holds, general best practices regarding last date of academic activity reporting, early walking at graduation, College Credit Plus, transcript charges, preferred names/legal names, working with smaller budgets and staffing issues, and the new EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDRP). Roundtable discussion included athletics and blocking out schedules, online programs, J-terms, and academic appeals. There were approximately 40 people in attendance.

Two lunchtime activities were offered; a Pharmacy tour, including the new mobile lab/clinic which offers health outreach services in Hardin County three to four days per week, and a tour of the law school's moot court rooms and its Rare Book and Special Collections Room.
